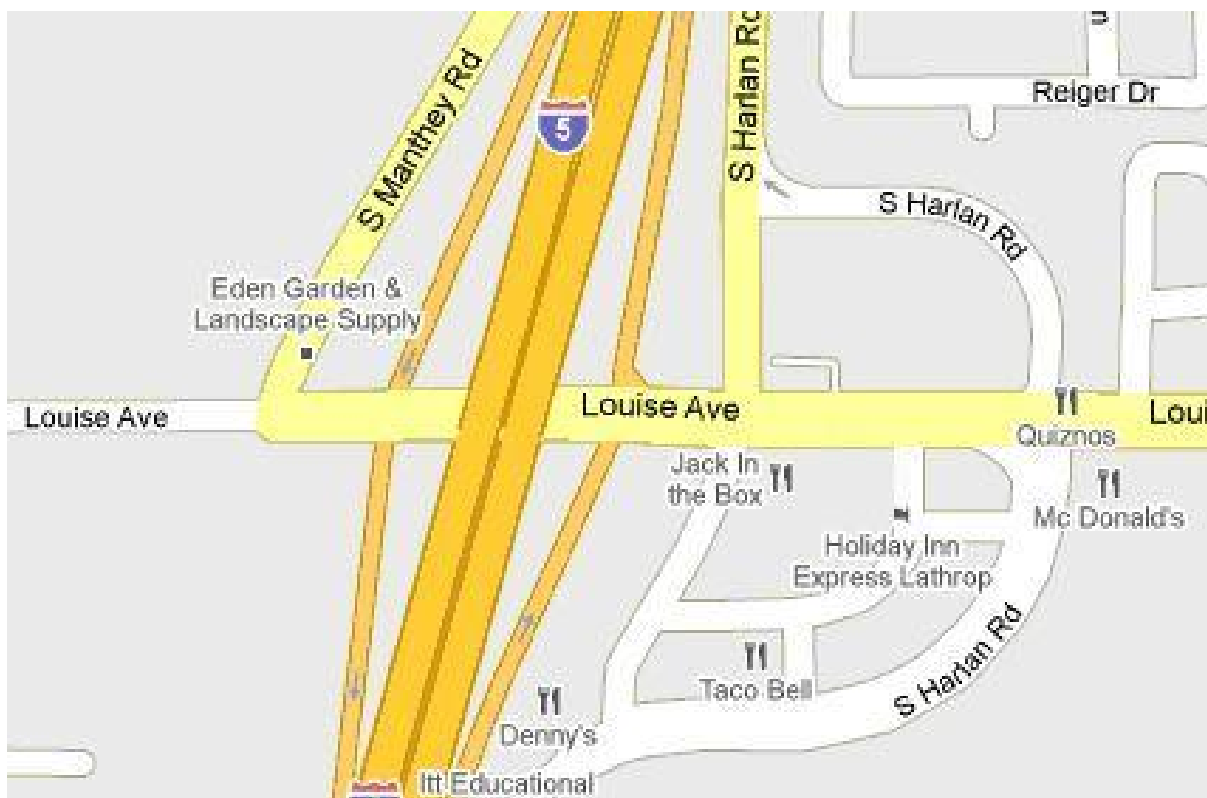

The City of Lathrop in conjunction with Caltrans will be making upgrades to the freeway interchange of Louise Avenue and I-5.

What: Louise Avenue Widening and Signal Improvements at Interstate 5

Project Area: There will be roadway and signal light construction on the following streets:

Louise Avenue between Harlan Road and Golden Valley Parkway



Approximate Construction Start and End Dates:

- January 2012 to Late Spring of 2012

Construction Methods:

The City's contractor (**Teichert Construction**) will use a combination of construction methods including open trench and underground boring to install new signal light conduits for modifications to signal lights. The north side of Louise Avenue under Interstate 5 will see sidewalk removal and retaining wall installation to accommodate street widening with additional lanes for a better traffic flow. A large area of Louise Avenue between Harlan Road and Golden Valley Parkway will have the Asphalt Rehabilitated. New Handicap compliant sidewalk with pedestrian crossings and ramps will be installed along the south side of Louise Avenue. There will be daily temporary lane closures as construction personnel complete work at each intersection, along shoulders and in the roadway. The work zone on Louise Avenue will at times affect the flow of traffic. Access to the I-5 freeway will be maintained as conditions permit with traffic control. Portions of the work will be completed during the night to lessen the impact to traffic.

Installing the improvements will at times temporarily interrupt access to driveways along Louise Avenue. The contractor will notify businesses and property owners well in advance of any interruptions.

What to Expect During Construction

- Construction hours are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The contractor may schedule working during the same hours on Saturdays.
- There is local access to all properties during construction, but you may experience some delays.
- Street parking is unavailable within the work zones at all hours.
- Watch for flaggers and follow their instructions for everyone's safety.
- Small crews will work in various areas to complete small tasks as needed.
- There may be periods of inactivity at some sites.
- Construction signage will direct traffic around construction areas to maintain a safe project area.
- A construction superintendent is on-site during work hours, and should be able to assist you with construction concerns. Superintendents typically wear a green/yellow safety vest and hard hat.

Alternate Routes: Lathrop Road / I-5 interchange will not be affected and will be the preferred alternate route to the I-5 freeway; access to the freeway system will also be available at the Yosemite Avenue / Highway 120 interchange

Teichert Construction will be distributing more information regarding the project and will be handling all Safety concerns during construction.
