NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following individual has resigned from the San Joaquin County Commission on Aging prior to the end of her term:

In accordance with Government Code Section 54974(a) this notice is posted within twenty days of notification of the vacancy.

Members of the Commission on Aging are appointed by each of the City Councils of each incorporated municipal entities within the County, each of the members of the Board of Supervisors, and by agencies providing services to seniors.

To be eligible for appointment as a member of this commission, one must be a resident of Lathrop. Membership shall strive to consist of more than 50% of individuals who are 60 years of age or older. Members serve for a period of three years and are expected to participate in regular meetings, as well as sub committees, as part of their duties.

Meetings of the Commission on Aging take place on the first Monday of the month. If the regular meeting date falls on a legal holiday, the meeting will be held the following Monday. Commission on Aging meetings are held at the San Joaquin County Agricultural Center: 2101 E. Earhart Avenue, Stockton, CA 95206.
