Permit Submittals — Residential Minor & Over-The-Counters

Online Permit Submittal Guidelines -

<u>Residential Minor Permits & Over-The-Counters – Solar, Patio Covers, Pools, Sheds. Re-Roofs,</u> <u>HVAC Replacements, Water Heater MEPs, Etc :</u>

- 1. Navigate to the <u>ePermits Portal</u>
- 2. Click "Request Permit"
- 3. Start typing Address. Address should not be typed in. Type the numbers and first 3 letter of street and wait for it to auto populate. If multiple addresses populate, select the best fit.
- 4. Call the Building Dept., (209)941-7270, to obtain the Parcel Number for your address.
- 5. Continue and fill out the required fields
- 6. Upload the required documents:
 - a. Building Permit Application (Required to Upload or permit request will be rejected)
 - b. Residential Permit Submittal Requirements
 - 1. Include all plans necessary per hand out. Title 24 Certifications & other documents requested. For additional information on what is required in your submittal package: <u>Building: Forms, Permits & Applications</u>.
- Once documents are uploaded, complete a submittal notification form using this link <u>Submittal/</u><u>Resubmittal/Payment Notifications</u> to notify the Building Dept. of resubmission.
 Failure to complete the notification process will result in the submittal not being processed.
 - a. You will be emailed with instructions to pay fees and/or upload any additional documents required for permit issuance.
- 8. No Physical Submissions

Required Document Naming Convention:

When uploading document **PDF files**, it will ask for your First/Last Name.

Use these fields as follows:

First Name = Plan Check cycle (PC1 or PC2 or PC3) (stands for PC1=Plan Check Cycle One, ETC.) Last Name = Street Address (1234 Easy St.)

Please label all documents as shown below. Include the Plan Check Cycle (PC1 or PC2 or PC3) Examples:
