

APPOINTMENT OF VOTING DELEGATE & ALTERNATE FOR THE 2022 LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Background

- TO REAL PROPERTY OF LATHROAD P
- Policy development is a key part of the League of California Cities (League) effectiveness.
- The League holds an Annual Conference and Business Meeting to decide League policy for the upcoming year.
- ▶ The Annual Conference will be held at the Long Beach Convention Center in Long Beach, California, September 7–9, 2022.

Background (cont.)

- The League's Annual Conference Resolutions is one way that city officials can directly participate in the development of League policy.
- Council action is required to designate a voting delegate (and up to two alternates) in order to participate in the Business Meeting.
- Each member City has the right to cast one vote on matter pertaining to League policy.

Background (cont.)

OF LATHROPS CHIRD

- Conference registration required.
- The approximate cost per person is estimated at \$1,500 per person:
 - League Registration \$650 (register by August 24)
 - Hotel/Transportation/Other \$850
- Currently, \$7,500 is available in the new Fiscal Year 22-23, budget for City Council training & travel expenses throughout the fiscal year.

Resolutions

- This year the League did not receive any Resolutions by the deadline.
- However, a petitioned Resolution can still be submitted during the Annual Conference and would need to be considered and voted on during the business meeting.
- There is an amendment to Cal Cities bylaws to be considered and voted on during the business meeting. This packet will be available to the members in mid-late August.
- The General Resolutions Committee will meet at 1 p.m. on Thursday, September 8, to consider the matters on the agenda and any petitioned resolutions made during the conference.
- Final vote of General Assembly 11:30 a.m., Sept. 9th
