Background

- Each year, representatives of the San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency (SJAFCA) Board of Directors travel to Washington, D.C., to meet with federal representatives and policymakers in Congress to discuss SJAFCA's priority projects.
- Lathrop has participated in these advocacy trips since joining SJAFCA as a voting member in 2018.
- This travel promotes regional projects and the City of Lathrop's future development, specifically as it relates to the Mossdale Tract.

Background (cont.)

- Travel is scheduled from April 9– April 11, 2024.
- City policy requires Council approval for all out of state travel
- Depending on the option selected a budget amendment may be required to cover the costs of the travel.
- Current Members to the SJAFCA Board of Directors: Akinjo (Delegate), Lazard (Alternate 1), and Torres-O'Callaghan (Alternate 2)
