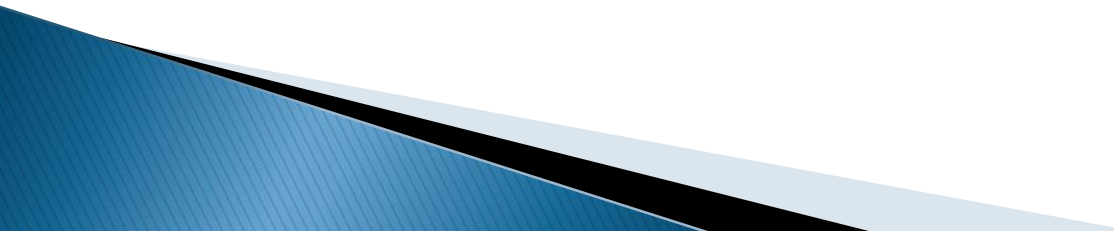




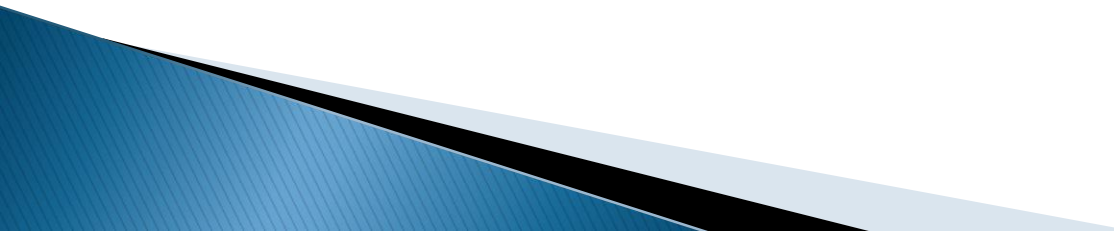
APPOINTMENT OF VOTING DELEGATE & ALTERNATE FOR THE 2026 LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Background

- ▶ Policy development is a key part of the League of California Cities (League) effectiveness.
 - ▶ The League holds an Annual Conference and Business Meeting to decide League policy for the upcoming year.
 - ▶ The Annual Conference will be held at the Anaheim Convention Center in Anaheim, California, September 23-25, 2026.
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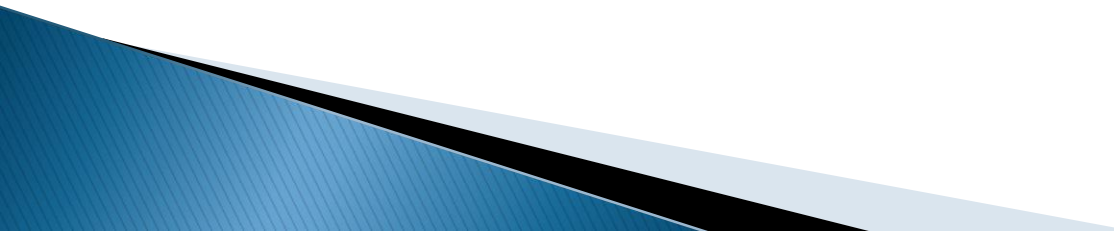
Background continued

- ▶ The League's Annual Conference Resolutions is one way that city officials can directly participate in the development of League policy.
 - ▶ Council action is required to designate a voting delegate (and up to two alternates) in order to participate in the Business Meeting.
 - ▶ Each member City has the right to cast one vote on matter pertaining to League policy.
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Conference Registration

- ▶ Conference registration required.
- ▶ The approximate cost per person is estimated at \$3,000 per person:
 - ▶ League Registration \$725 (register by September 1st)
 - ▶ Hotel/Transportation/Other \$2,275

Resolutions to be Voted on

- ▶ Resolutions must be submitted to Cal Cities by July 25, 2026 (60 days before the conference)
 - ▶ Petitioned Resolution(s) may still be submitted during the Annual Conference for a vote at the business meeting.
 - ▶ The General Resolutions Committee will meet on September 24th to consider agenda items and petitioned Resolutions
 - ▶ Final vote of General Assembly – 8:30 a.m., September 25th
 - ▶ Resolutions approved by the General Assembly at the Annual Conference become official League policy.
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Appointment Discussion

- ▶ For 2026, Mayor Akinjo serves as the City Delegate to the League's Central Valley Executive Committee, and Councilmember Diallo serves as the City's Alternate.
 - ▶ 2026 Annual Conference Registration Requested by Mayor Akinjo, Vice Mayor Torres-O'Callaghan, and Councilmember Diallo.
 - ▶ **Action Requested:** Council to discuss and appoint the Voting Delegate and up to two Alternate(s).
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
