


Why this is the right move, right now

- The City of Lathrop has worked diligently to reach financial stability.
- Due to the City Council's fiscal stewardship, Lathrop is one of the ten most financially sound cities in California.
- Because of the city's strong financial position, Lathrop has the resources needed to transition from contracting policing services to its own Police Department by July 1, 2022.

- Creating our own City Police
 Department will provide
 expanded service tailored to

- The long-term cost-saving projections are clear - the City of Lathrop will provide more services at less cost by creating its own.



Assumptions:

City of Lathrop

1. City Retirement escalates at an average 3% per year1.

San Joaquin County Sheriff

- SJC Sheriff Retirement Tier 1 escalates at an average 5.91% per year (last 8 year average).
- 2. SJC Sheriff Retirement Tier 2 escalates at an average of 7% per year (last 8 year average).
