


Transportation & Infrastructure


Air	Stockton Metropolitan Airport is located 8 miles northeast of Lathrop. Passenger services are available through Allegiant Airlines. Air Cargo and General Aviation are supported by a 10,649' runway. Four international airports are proximate to Lathrop: Oakland-OAK (57 miles); San Jose-SJC (64 miles); Sacramento-SMF (67 miles); San Francisco-SFO (75 miles).
Bus	San Joaquin Regional Transit District (SJRTD) serves Lathrop offering "County Hopper Service" Route 97 and "Interregional Commuter Service" – Route 152 to Livermore. "Van Go" is a dial-a-ride type service available throughout the County.
Interstates & Highways	Immediate access to Interstate 5 (north-south), Interstate 205 (east-west), and State Route Highway 120 (east-west) offer immediate connectivity to large population centers. State Route Highway 99 (north-south) is located 4 miles to the east of Lathrop.
Maritime	Port of Stockton (Bulk Cargo services) is located 11 miles north of Lathrop. Port of Oakland (Container services) is located 63 miles west of Lathrop.
Overnight Shipping	Providers include: FedEx, United Parcel Service (UPS), United States Postal Service (USPS), Golden State Overnight, and OnTrac Shipping.
Rail	Passenger- Altamont Corridor Express (ACE) provides commuter service between Stockton and San Jose with daily stops at the Lathrop/Manteca station. Amtrak also provides limited passenger service at the Lathrop/Manteca station. A future passenger rail service, called Valley Link, has plans to be operational by year 2028. Valley Link will have two stations in Lathrop to offer public transit between Lathrop and the Dublin-Pleasanton Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) station. Freight- Union Pacific Railroad Intermodal facility is located adjacent to Lathrop City limits, and the BNSF Railways Intermodal facility is located 10 miles northeast of Lathrop.
Truck	More than twenty-five (25) carriers are located in Lathrop, including: Old Dominion, Swift Transportation, Heartland Express with each offering a variety of logistics services including FTL, LTL, Commodities, Dedicated, Intermodal, COFC and TOFC. Numerous local and regionally-based carriers and 3PL's provide intrastate goods movement services.

A SMALL CITY WITH A BIG PRESENCE... LATHROP, CALIFORNIA

Lathrop (San Joaquin County), encompassing 23 square miles, is located 70 miles east of San Francisco and 55 miles south of Sacramento at the northern end of the San Joaquin Valley. The San Joaquin River and Interstate 5 bisect the City to the west, and the Union Pacific Railway to the east. Offering immediate access to Interstate 5, Interstate 205 and Highway 120, the City of Lathrop is truly at the crossroads of commerce making it the "SMART" choice location for residents, businesses, and industry.

Incorporated in 1989, Lathrop continues to grow with residential, commercial and industrial development. The region's population is exploding as San Francisco Bay Area workers choose communities like Lathrop to purchase affordable homes that offer a family friendly environment and great quality of life.

The California State Department of Finance's May 2023 rankings listed Lathrop as the "Fastest Growing City with a Population over 30,000" at 11.1%. The City also ranked number one (#1) in "City Under 300,000 with the Largest Numeric Change" and the greatest "Percent of Multi-Family Housing Unit Growth". Lathrop ranked number two (#2) in both "Percent Total Housing Unit Growth" and "Percent Single Family Housing Unit Growth". Current population in the City of Lathrop is 35,080 with 786,145 people in San Joaquin County.

The City holds multiple community events for its residents to enjoy, such as its annual July 1st celebration of its incorporation, which this year marked 34 years, and two new events held in 2023 to recognize the first anniversary of the Lathrop Police Department, and an event honoring Juneteenth.

Innovative city leadership focuses on intelligently planned growth and development. River Islands at Lathrop (riverislands.com) and Stanford Crossing (stanfordcrossing.com) are two such master planned communities. At full build-out, these two communities will account for more than 16,860 single-family homes.

The city's industrial sector has 19 million square feet of existing building space with 3.2 million square feet planned in new construction. Lathrop's major employers include Tesla, United Parcel Service, Wayfair, Ashley Furniture, California Natural Products, CBC Steel Buildings/ Nucor, and more.

Lathrop's newest commercial announcements included Sprouts Farmers Market, Fairfield Inn by Marriott, Chevron, Jamba Juice, and Blue Rain Car Wash. The City has more than 8,900 linear feet of commercial space fronting Interstate 5 with multiple pad sites and acreage available for new development.

Lathrop offers a business friendly environment where leadership and staff work collaboratively with developers and the business community to understand project timing needs for permitting and regulatory requirements. Quality of Life

Education & Training: University of the Pacific, California State University Stanislaus-Stockton campus, Humphrey's University, San Joaquin Delta College, ten (10) specialized private colleges and multiple career technology education (CTE) focused adult schools provide a variety of education and training opportunities for Lathrop businesses and residents.

K-12 Schools: The Lathrop community is served by five elementary and one high school under the Manteca Unified School District. Residents in River Islands are served under Banta Unified School District with three elementary schools and a high school, which is currently under construction.

Churches: There are more than twelve (12) houses of worship in Lathrop, and numerous denominational and non-denominational options in neighboring communities.

Civic & Social Amenities: Lathrop Branch Library, Senior Center, Generations Center, and Community Center offer a variety of programs and activities throughout the year. Cultural amenities including symphonies, auditoriums, and special event venues are in close proximity to the City.

Parks & Entertainment: Lathrop residents enjoy twenty-six (26) parks and three (3) recreation facilities. Park amenities include picnic and barbecue areas, softball fields, basketball, volleyball, exercise equipment, playgrounds, and interactive fountains -- even a skate park and dog park. The City holds an annual birthday celebration for its incorporation on July 1st. The Parks and Recreation staff offer year round activities for residents of all ages. Dell'Osso Family Farms hosts family friendly seasonal attractions to include a Pumpkin Maze and Holidays on the Farm.

Medical Facilities: There are over 1,000 hospital beds within a fifteen minute radius of Lathrop. Hospitals include San Joaquin County General (French Camp); Kaiser Permanente Medical Center (Manteca); Dameron (Stockton); St. Joseph's (Stockton); and Sutter-Tracy Community Hospital (Tracy).

Hospitality: There are seven (7) hotels in Lathrop to include: Comfort Inn, Days Inn, Fairfield Inn by Marriott, Hampton Inn & Suites, Holiday Inn Express, Quality Inn & Suites, and Tru by Hilton. Two more hotels are approved but pending construction west of Interstate 5. Including planned and under construction projects, the total room count in Lathrop is 663.
