

Mandatory Organic Recycling Requirements

As of January 1, 2022, all residents, multi-family residential dwellings and commercial businesses in the City of Lathrop must comply with the State's recycling and organic waste requirements, commonly known as Senate Bill (SB) 1383 Short-Lived Climate Pollutants.

To comply with this state mandate, all solid waste generators will need to subscribe to organic / green waste (e.g., yard trimmings, food waste) collection services unless they are located in a low population waiver area (Title 14 Calif. Code of Regulations Section 18984.12(a)) or receive a waiver from the City in accordance with Lathrop Municipal Code, Section 8.16.290, Mandatory Organic Waste Disposal Reduction.

To apply for waiver, please complete this application and specify the waiver type requested, type(s) of collection services for which you are requesting a waiver, the reason(s) for such waiver, and provide documentation supporting such request. Staff will review this application to determine if the location is eligible for a waiver.

The waiver is valid for five years. If circumstances change such that commercial business or multi-family premises may no longer qualify for the waiver granted, the City may revoke a waiver. Any waiver holder must cooperate with the City or its designee for any on-site assessment or inspection of the appropriateness of the waiver.

- Explanation of why decreasing size of garbage and/or recycling containers to accommodate the smallest cart of compost/organics collection service is not an option.
- Explanation of why shared collection service with nearby businesses is not an option.
