2.1 PARKS, RECREATION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES UPDATE

Parks, Recreation and Maintenance Services Director Todd Sebastian reported the following update:

- Recreation Programs and Events Update
 Gave an overview on past events that were all well attended including "Trunk or Treat", "Veterans Day", "Donuts with Santa", "Tree Lighting" and the "Christmas Parade" which was transformed into a Winter Wonderland experience in the Scott Brooks Gym when the parade was cancelled due to rain. Successful programs include Culinary Kids, Art, Mini Movers, JR. NBA, and Teen and Senior Special Events.
- Park and Maintenance Services
 Staff took a proactive approach to storm preparedness, which proved to be very successful as there was not any significant problems during the storms.
- New City GoGov App
 The new City App "Lathrop Cares" has been well received with

hundreds of downloads and over 230 requests. Staff receives requests immediately, which allows for a quick response time.

Park Update

The renovation of Milestone Manor Park is scheduled to begin shortly and should be completed in August. The park will receive a play structure, picnic area, fencing, a walking path and other amenities. Tidewater Park will be receiving exercise equipment. Thomsen Park will become a dog park. The Green will be getting a new play structure. Development has started on Lions Park and will have an agricultural theme. Rotary Park will likely have a Grand Opening over the summer. River Park North is a linear park that will include a fitness station and a ropes course design. Community Park C-1 in River Islands will have a splash pad, play structure, fitness area, picnic area and basketball court. Community Park C-2 in River Islands will have multiple baseball fields and will have an all-inclusive play structure. Land on Shilling Avenue is a potential site for a new neighborhood park.

Rec C.A.M.P

Parks, Recreation and Maintenance Services Director Todd Sebastian and Recreation Manager Melissa Stathakopoulos will attend Rec C.A.M.P in June in Boulder, Colorado. Participants will tour multiple Community Centers, both new and old, while learning what programs, amenities were successful, and which were not.
