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ADDENDUM NO. 1 – July 17, 2025

Tesla Drive and Christopher Way Pavement Rehabilitation CIP PS 24-05

This addendum amends the Contract Drawings and Specifications for this project as follows:

1. To be deemed as "Equally Approved" pavement reinforcing material, the alternative product must have similar components, functionality, and a minimum maintenance service of 7 years on a City of Lathrop public road

The following Requests for Information (RFI) have been received by the City, and are followed by the City's answer (A):

RFI 1: Please clarify the weigh back for emulsion and aggregate the specifications state that any material that will be brought back must be weighed at a certified commercial scale within 25 miles.

A1: Excess aggregate or emulsion returned to the source or to other projects <u>will not</u> be required to be scaled at a commercial scale as long as the truck is calibrated and delivery tickets are provided.

RFI 2: Could you please confirm that crack sealing is not required on this project?

A2: The City will complete the crack sealing in-house and thus is not required as part of the Project scope.

When submitting the bid for the project, the Contractor must acknowledge receipt of the addendum.
