ITEM: **ESTABLISH A SUBCOMMITTEE AND APPROVE A BUDGET NOT TO EXCEED \$200 FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CITY'S TRUNK-OR-TREAT EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION: **Establish a Subcommittee and Approve a Budget Not to Exceed \$200 for Participation in the City's Trunk-or-Treat Event Taking Place on October 17, 2026 From 5:00 PM - 7:00 PM at the Lathrop Generations Center**

SUMMARY:

On Saturday, October 17, 2026, the City of Lathrop will host its annual Trunk-or-Treat event. The Trunk-or-Treat event will begin at 5:00 p.m. at the Lathrop Generations Center at 450 Spartan Way. The event provides an opportunity for residents and local businesses to participate by creating themed trunk displays, dressing up in costume, and handing out candy to attendees.

The Senior Advisory Commission (SAC) seeks to establish a subcommittee that is responsible for registering and participating in the event, choosing the theme, decorations, costumes and passing out candy at the event. The expenditure for supplies will not exceed the \$200 budget.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Lathrop will host the annual Trunk-or-Treat event on Saturday, October 17, 2026, beginning at 5:00 p.m. at the Lathrop Generations Center, including Leland and Jane Stanford Park. The event will have over sixty vehicles for participants to trick or treat from, music, food trucks, and a costume contest. More than 3,000 people are anticipated to attend the event this year.

The SAC seeks to establish a subcommittee that is responsible the event and budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends SAC establish a subcommittee and approve a budget not to exceed \$200 to participate in the Trunk-or-Treat Event taking place on October 17, 2026 From 5:00 PM - 7:00 PM at the Lathrop Generations Center.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The SAC operates its own account of funds and shall not exceed a budget of \$200 towards supplies for the Trunk-or-Treat event.

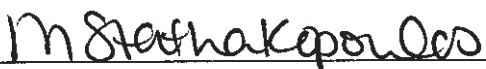

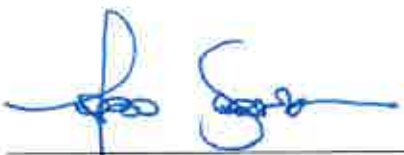
